Monitoring of Farm Yard Emission (Dairy) Cattle Farms

For phase 1 of this research you will do the following: a review and evaluation of different sensor technologies, statistical support for the determination of the sample of dairy farms and the selection of these dairy farms. You will then perform all preparatory actions required for the research and carry out the research. Finally, you will work out and report the measurement data.

Your working environment:

Our office is located at WaterCampus, Oostergoweg 9 in Leeuwarden, The Netherlands. Here you will do an internship in a team of permanent employees and a group of students (10 to 20). In addition, you can regularly be found at various dairy farms and in the Water Application Centre (WAC) to take samples and analyse them.

In addition, you have a strong sense of responsibility and you are able to represent the CEW in a professional manner. You can work well independently as well as in a team.
